The candidate engaged on consolidated remuneration will not be entitled to residential accommodation, official transport, leave encashment or any other allowances/facilities as admissible to a regular employee. Relaxation clause:

- 1. A relaxation of 5% marks may be provided at Graduate and Master's level for the Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe/Differently-abled (Physically and visually differently-abled)/Other Backward Class (OBC) (Non-creamy layer) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions.
