6. **Scheme of Examination:** The selection will be made entirely on the basis of merit. The selection process will comprise of Skill/Physical/Practical test and written test, wherever necessary. The selection in all Group 'C' posts will be made solely based on marks obtained by the applicants in the written test and subject to qualifying in the Skill/Physical/Practical test, as may be the case.

7. The subjects of the written test, number of questions, maximum marks and duration will be as follows:-

**Note:** The question papers of Written Test will be bilingual (in English & Hindi). However, the question on the portion of English Language subject will be in English only. There will be provision of negative marking (0.25 marks) in each wrong answer in written test for technical posts.

#### 7. **Subjective Examination**

(i) **General Intelligence & Reasoning:** The questions will be in Assamese/English and would include questions of non-verbal type. The test may include questions on analogies, similarities and differences, space visualization, picture coding, analysis, judgment, direction sense, visual memory, discrimination, observation, relationship, classification, figure classification, administrative/arithmetic, logical, non-verbal series. The test will also include questions designed to test the candidate's ability to deal with abstract diagrams, symbols and their relationship, arithmetical-comparison and other analytical functions.

(ii) **General Knowledge:** The questions will be of illustration standard. The questions will be designed to test the ability of candidate's general awareness of the environment around him/her and its application in society. Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday occurrence and importance in their scientific aspects as may be required of the candidate's expected educational standard. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighboring countries, especially pertaining to Sports, History, Culture, Geography, Economic, Social, General Knowledge including Indian Constitution and Scientific Research etc. These questions will be suitable, key word region, geographicality of geographicality.

(iii) **General Language:** The questions will be of Metropolitan standard. Candidates understanding the basics of English language in vocabulary, grammar, sentence analysis, synonyms, antonyms and its correct usage. The questions shall be in Hindi.

(iv) **Mathematical Aptitude:** The paper will include questions on problems relating to Number Systems, Computation of Whole Numbers, Fractions and Decimals and relationship between Numbers, Fundamental Arithmetic Operations, Percentages, Ratio and Proportion, Averages, Interest, Profit & Loss, Discount, use of Tables and Graphs, Mensuration, Time and Distance, Time and Work etc.
