
Sub: Framing of Recruitment Rules (RRs) for filling up the post of Group "C" of NDRF Academy, Nagpur-reg.

Notification

G.S.R.....(E) In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Group 'C' in the National Disaster Response Force Academy, Nagpur, namely:—

1. **Short title and commencement.**- (1) These rules may be called National Disaster Response Force Academy, Nagpur, Group 'C'(Non-Gazetted) Recruitment Rules, 2022.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Number of posts, classification and level in the pay matrix.** - The number of posts, its classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications, etc.** - The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in column (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. **Disqualification.** - No person,—

- (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having spouse living; or
- (b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from operation of this rule.

5. **Power to relax.** - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reason to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. **Saving.** - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided to the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
